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


Map of Northern Australia








Governance Systems Analysis Method Collective Analysis to Improve Complex Beasts

Key Scenarios Without Systemic Improvement:


Gilbert River Region

Scenario 2: Wildcard development risks.



Scenario 3: Long term sustainable development of the Gilbert catchment




Key Forward Directions: Douglas Daly Region

- Solution 1: Local Indigenous Nation Building & Country-based Planning.
- Solution 2: Establishing an Integrated Agricultural RD&E Hub.
- Solution 3: Collective Approaches to Managing Trade-Offs
- Solution 4: Progression of a Pilot Bio-regional Planning Approach
- Solution 5: Trialing New Approach to Delivering Offset and Ecosystem Service Markets
- Solution 6: Building Knowledge Coordination System for Condition and Trend Monitoring and Future Development Assessment



Emerging Directions: Pilbara Region (Tentative Only)

- Success of the Pilbara Region has major implications for the Australian Economy.
- Much bigger implications emerging from the lack of social assessment in EPBC work.
- Existing resource rights largely locked in, necessitating genuine partnership between governments, resource industry, TOs & the region's pastoralists for regional planning.
- Significant offset money in the system (PEOF), but still no strong and prioritised works planning and delivery framework.




Summary and Where to From Here

- Without strong regional planning, outlook scenarios are poor.
- Ongoing support for progression of solutions in each region.
- Towards a package approach to enhanced regional planning activities in these three priority regions.
- Explicitly work with DCCEEW on regional offset governance.
- Strong desire to continue a vibrant Community of Practice.
